Wage and Benefit Settlements - 2010

Wage and benefit settlements reported to the Construction Labor Research Council so far in 2010 have resulted in an average first year increase of \$.55 or 1.1 percent. This is down considerably from the average of \$1.49 or 3.1 percent

reported for the comparable period a year earlier. Second and third year settlements are also lower, but by lesser amounts

Small or no increases were widespread. Almost a quarter of new agreements were freezes or reductions and about two-thirds were less than two percent. Similarly, about two-thirds of the first year increases were less than one dollar.
